The 2017 WASCE Result for the SS3 students

The analysis of the school performance in the above examination has been published on the school website and is also available in the recently developed ISI NewsApp. I am glad to note that this year's result remains the best in the history of the school so far. SS2 Students

Management held a meeting with all SS2 students in the course of the term to address the issue of subject selection. The students have been instructed not to drop any subject until after the Mock Examination in SS3 early next year. However, we have had one-on-one counselling sessions with them regarding their desired courses of study in the University vis-à-vis subjects offered and UTME subjects that will be written. We advise parents not to instruct them to drop any subject(s) yet, as against the school directive, please. Parents are further advised to seek further clarification(s) on the above from the Principal, please.

2017 GCE for all SS2 students (Private candidate examination)

205 SS2 students have registered for the examination. It will hold in the school between September and October 2017. Since it is not a school examination, candidates are expected to attend the examination in mufti and be well behaved. Thugery or any act of indiscipline will not be permitted.

SS3 Students

The newly promoted SS3 students are expected back in school to commence the holiday classes which will run between Tuesday, 1st and Thursday, 31st August 2017. This is meant to prepare them very well for their GCE. Any day student who wishes to board during the period should apply in writing to the Principal, please. Payment of school fees

We appreciate parents who are always paying up their children's school fees promptly and encourage those who do not, to make efforts to pay up, promptly too. The payment will be acknowledged by the issuance of receipt, which concerned parents can pick up from the Accounts Unit of the school.
- vii. As a matter of school policy, all JS3 and SS3 students are to pay the 1st, 2nd and 3rd Terms fees at the beginning of the next academic session. To this end, amount payable is as follows:
JS3: Staff - ₦175,750.00 Non-Staff - ₦235,750.00
SS3: Staff - ₦182,750.00 Non-Staff - ₦242,750.00
PTA: JS3/SS3: Staff/Non Staff - ₦2,000.00 per session

I am happy to inform all parents that the Governing Board at its meeting of Monday, 24 July 2017, graciously approved this insurance plan.

The purpose of the insurance plan is to ensure that our children's education is secured throughout their stay in ISI should any of death, critical illness or permanent total disability happens to us. It was also agreed that the premium payment should start at the commencement of the 2017/18 school year.
