- Ten students participated in The Africa Mathematics Olympiad quiz competition organised in all states in Nigeria. All ISI students performed exceptionally well and won medals and certificates of merit. Okeowo Ayomikun (JSS3) was awarded a cash prize of N50,000 for having perfect score (100%). Also, his Mathematics teacher was awarded a cash prize of N50,000.00 and the School was given a trophy for this performance.

Payment of School Fees

Parents/Guardians are to note that ISI is introducing a new platform which will enable easier payments of requisite fees. This new platform will be communicated to our parents shortly. However, parents should note the requisite fees for the new session.

- a. School fees for first term 2023/24 session are as follows: **JSS2, SSS1 and SSS2: Staff: ₦84,800.00 Non-Staff: ₦104,800.00.**

- b. Parents/Guardians of JSS3 and SSS3 students are reminded to complete payment for first, second and third terms on or before resumption. The details are as follows:

JSS3: Staff: ₦222,300.00; Non-staff: ₦282,300.00
SSS3: Staff: ₦231,800.00; Non-staff: ₦291,800.00

- c. Parents/Guardians of JSS3 and SSS3 students are to note that school fees payment for first, second and third terms must be made before the registration of any external examination. Any student who fails to make the payment for the three terms will not be registered for any external examination.
- d. Boarding Fee: **₦188,000.00.**
- e. Boarding form: **₦500.00.**

f. **ICT Fee: N8,000.** This fee is **optional** and is meant to be paid by parents/guardians who want their children/wards to be part of the extra tuition (tutorials) in programmes like Microsoft Word, Adobe, Dreamweaver, CorelDraw and so on.

g. **Other fees which are to be paid into their designated accounts are:**

i. **PTA Levy: N3,000.00** per session to be paid into **ISI-PTA First Bank Account No. 2005497814.**

ii. **Boarding Supervision Fee: N2,500.00** to be paid into **ISI Boarder Parents Forum First Bank Account No. 2017593645.**

iii. **Boarders Lesson Fee: JSS (N10,200.00); SSS (N12,700.00)** to be paid into **ISI Boarder Parents Forum First Bank Account No. 2017593645.**

Holiday Extension for Prospective SSS3 Students (2023/24 Session)

All prospective SSS3 students are expected to commence their **extension classes on Monday, 7th August, 2023.** Hostel facilities are available from Sunday, 6th August till Saturday, 9th September, 2023. **The classes shall start on 07/08/2023 and end on 07/09/2023.** Any day student who desires to be in the hostel during this period is free to do so. Student's Dress Code

In ISI, we constantly encourage our students to be modestly and decently dressed at all times. Girls' gowns **should not be tight-fitting** and should cover their knees while boys' shorts should be in the range of the knee cap. Senior boys are **not permitted** to come to school in jeans or tightly-sewn trousers otherwise known as 'pencil'. The recommended colour of shoes is black; **no other colour is allowed**. The sole of shoes should be black as well. **Only white or black pairs of socks are allowed. Ankle socks are not allowed**. Shoes should be flat and not high-heeled. Boots are not allowed. Shoes and socks that do not conform to the school rules and regulations will be confiscated. Boys' haircut should be **very low and even** and girls on afro must have their haircut even. Other styles of haircut apart from this are not allowed in the School.

Electronic Gadgets in School

This is to remind our parents that the school does not permit students coming to school with mobile phones for whatsoever reason. Any phone seen with our students will be confiscated and **the school will not return any confiscated gadget**. The seized items will be donated during Charity Programme to the less-privileged.
