**The School Promotion Criteria**

According to our regulations in ISI, students are promoted to the next class upon meeting up with certain requisite promotion criteria. The promotion criteria are as stated herein:

- **SS Arts students:** 5 credits including English Language, Mathematics **and** any three of the following subjects: Lit-in-Eng; Government; History; IRS/CRS; Visual Art/Music/French; Yoruba; Igbo; Hausa; Biology; Geography and Economics.
- **SS Commercial students:** 5 credits including English Language, Mathematics, Economics **and** any two of the following subjects: Financial Account; Commerce; Government; Geography; Biology, CRS/IRS and Visual Art.
- **SS Science students:** 5 credits including English Language, Mathematics, Chemistry, Physics **and** any of the following subjects: Biology; Geography; Economics; Further Maths; Technical Drawing; Agricultural Science; Food and Nutrition and Visual Art.
- **JS students:** 7 credits including English Language and Mathematics.  
Please note that the minimum **credit pass is 50%**.

**Awards/Laurels**

Eleven ISI students attended a reading competition in honour of Prof. Wole Soyinka's 90<sup>th</sup> birthday celebration organised by Nigeria Copyright Commission in collaboration with the Association of Nigerian Authors and the Department of Theatre Arts, UI. **Adebayo-Oke Ewaoluwa represented the school in the competition and took the overall best position.** The school was rewarded with copies of the titles, *Ake* and *The Lion and the Jewel* while a certificate was presented to Ewaoluwa.

**Payment of School Fees**

Parents/Guardians are to note the following:

- a. School fees for first term 2024/25 session are as follows: **JSS2, SSS1 and SSS2: Staff: ₦102,700.00 Non-Staff: ₦122,700.00.**
- b. Parents/Guardians of JSS3 and SSS3 students are reminded to complete payment for first, second and third terms on or before resumption. The details are as follows:  
**JSS3: Staff: ₦272,300.00; Non-staff: ₦332,300.00**  
**SSS3: Staff: ₦281,800.00; Non-staff: ₦341,800.00**

**Note:** Parents/Guardians of JSS3 and SSS3 students are to note that school fees payment for first, second and third terms must be made before the registration of any external examination. Any student who fails to make the payment for the three terms will not be registered for any external examination.

Parents/Guardians of JSS3 and SSS3 students are allowed to pay in two equal tranches if they so desire.

- c. Boarding Fee: **₦283,500.**
- d. **ICT Fee: ₦8,000.** This fee is **optional** and is meant to be paid by parents/guardians who want their children/wards to be part of the extra tuition (tutorials) in programmes like Microsoft Word, Adobe, Dreamweaver, CorelDraw and so on.
- e. **Boarding form: ₦500.00**
- f. **PTA Levy: ₦3,000.00** per session to be paid into **ISI PTA First Bank Account No. 2005497814.**
- g. **Boarding Supervision Fee: ₦2,500.00** to be paid into **ISI Boarder Parents Forum First Bank Account No. 2017593645.**
- h. **Boarders Lesson Fee:** JSS (**₦10,200.00**); SSS (**₦12,700.00**) to be paid into **ISI Boarder Parents Forum First Bank Account No. 2017593645.**

#### **Important Information on Third Term Payment of Fees**

We appreciate our esteemed parents for your support in ensuring that we migrated successfully to the new payment portal. We also appreciate your feedback and we are committed to serving you better. Kindly note that the above **fees (a-e) must be paid through isi.ui.edu.ng**. The steps for these payments are stated herein:

- a. Log on to the ISI site (isi.ui.edu.ng) and click on payment.
- b. Enter your username (i.e., your child's admission number) and your password (enter 1234 as the default password if you are using the platform for your ward for the first time).
- c. Click on the payment you intend to make (e.g. school fee or boarding fee)
- d. Click on submit. You will be redirected to REMITA where you will select your option of payment.
- e. Provide necessary details, submit, confirm if payment is successful and generate receipt.

**NOTE:** If your payment option in (e) is bank branch, you will be given RRR (Remita Retrieval Reference) which will be used to make payment at the bank. After payment, go back to your dashboard, click on confirm payment, enter the RRR and click on submit. Confirm the payment and generate your receipt.

#### **Holiday Extension for Prospective SSS3 Students (2024/25 Session)**

All SSS3 students are expected to commence their **extension classes on Monday, 5th August, 2024**. Hostel facilities are available from Sunday, 4th August till Friday, 30th August, 2024. **Classes shall start on 05/08/2024 and end on 30/08/2024**. Any day student who desires to be in the hostel during this period is free to do so. However, a letter must be written to the principal. Details of requisite charges are in the table below.

**Note:** Every student must present the evidence of payment before he/she is admitted into the dormitory. The hostel fee must be paid through the school online payment portal.

#### **Morning and Afternoon Classes for SSS2 and SSS3 Classes**

Extension classes for the SSS2 and SSS3 students will continue upon resumption for the new session. In view of this, all SSS2 and SSS3 students are expected to resume for early morning classes in school at 7AM. Afternoon classes shall commence at 3PM. A timetable to this effect will be released immediately school resumes in September. Students are strongly advised to be present and punctual. Extension classes for SSS1 students will commence by the second term of the session.

### **Coming Late to School**

Few students still come late to school in spite of the continuous sensitisation against this. All students are expected to be in school latest 8AM and be part of the daily morning assembly.

We have discovered that the late-coming of students to school is mostly caused by parents. Consequently, we plead with parents who drop their children in school daily to be alive to this responsibility and ensure they drop them in school early.

### **Student's Dress Code (School Uniform and Shoes; House Wears for Boarders)**

In ISI, we constantly encourage modest and decent dressing at all times. Therefore, girls' **gowns should not be tight-fitting** and should cover their knees while boys' shorts should be in the range of the knee cap. Senior boys are **not**

**permitted** to come to school in jeans or tightly-sewn trousers otherwise known as 'pencil'. The recommended colour of shoes is black; **no other colour is allowed**. The sole of shoes should be black as well. **Only white or black pairs of socks are allowed. Ankle socks are not allowed**. Shoes should be flat and not high-heeled. Boots are not allowed. Shoes and socks that do not conform to the school rules and regulations will be confiscated. Boys' haircut should be **very low and even and girls on afro must have their haircut even**. Other styles of haircut apart from this are not allowed in the School.

### **Electronic Gadgets in School**

This is to remind our parents that the school does not permit students coming to school with mobile phones for whatsoever reason. Any phone seen with our students will be confiscated and **the school will not return any confiscated gadget**. The seized items will be donated during Charity Programme to the less-privileged.

### **Boarders Dining Etiquette**

As a matter of necessity, each boarder student should resume to school with sufficient cutlery. No boarder will be allowed to lend or borrow any type of cutlery.
